36th Annual Miss Odyssey Pageant: “Be-YOU-tiful!”

Contestants will be judged on beauty, poise, and presentation. School and community activities will be read to introduce the contestants but will not be considered in the judging. Each contestant will appear twice: Initially, in an introduction segment dressed in sportswear while bio information is being read, and again in a second segment dressed in formal attire. During the formal attire segment, each contestant will be asked a **brief interview question** based on the information and specific interests listed per your entry form. You will be given fifteen to thirty seconds to respond.

Prizes will be awarded to **Miss Odyssey, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Runners-up, Miss Congeniality, Most Photogenic (one for Judges’ Choice and one for Lassiter’s Choice) and People’s Choice Award. Miss Odyssey** will also be featured at next year’s Homecoming Parade. There will be a selection of **Class Beauties** from each grade level: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior. The number of class beauties will be based on the number of contestants per grade level.

The pageant entry fee is **\$75.00**. Every girl who enters by the deadline will receive a T-shirt to wear to school on the Friday before the pageant. Entry forms can be obtained from the Lassiter Cheer website, www.lassitercheerleading.org, in the main office, or outside Room 206. Please bring all fees and entry forms to either the main office or Room 206 no later than **Friday, January 12th to guarantee receiving a T-shirt. All checks should be made payable to the Trojan Cheer Booster Club. The first ten applicants will receive a gift card.**

Most Photogenic: Each contestant will have a head shot photographed at the initial Miss Odyssey meeting on **Thursday, January 18th** to be entered in the “Most Photogenic” category. Most Photogenic will be selected by both the judges and the Lassiter student body. Lassiter student voting will take place outside the cafeteria the week of January 22nd.

People’s Choice Award: The audience has an opportunity to cast their vote for their favorite contestant for only \$1.00 per vote! This can be done in the lobby before the pageant starts or during intermission. All votes must be submitted by end of intermission. A person may vote as many times as they like.

Modeling Contract Award Winner: A modeling contract will be separately judged and awarded to a pageant participant by a modeling agent. The person who is crowned Miss Odyssey will not necessarily be the awarded this contract.

Prizes:

- \$500 scholarship for Miss Odyssey
- \$250 scholarship for 1st Runner-Up
- Monetary scholarship for 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Runner-Up

Miss Congeniality:

- All contestants will have the opportunity to vote for Miss Congeniality during preparation for the pageant.
- Winning this prize **DOES NOT** disqualify a girl from other awards.

Initial Meeting:

- All contestants will meet **Thursday, January 18th** after school from **3:45 pm to 4:15 pm** to receive information vital to preparing for the pageant.
- A goodie bag will be given to all contestants at this meeting.

Dress Rehearsal:

- Contestants should bring the shoes they intend to use in the pageant, but full dress is not needed.
- Stage direction and parade instruction will be presented by previous pageant contestants.
- All contestants are expected to be present. Rehearsals are scheduled for **Wednesday, January 24th and Thursday, January 25th after school from 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm in the Lassiter Concert Hall.**

Photographer:

- A photographer will be taking pictures of all contestants on pageant night. Pictures will be ongoing throughout the pageant for all contestants and afterward for winners' photos.
- Information regarding photo packages and related cost will be given out at rehearsals.

Dressing Rooms:

- Only contestants and designated student dressing room assistants will be allowed in the dressing rooms.
- Parents and friends are not allowed in the dressing room area.

Pageant Tickets/Flowers:

- **Reserved seating** is available for **\$15** per seat and must be pre-purchased. These seats will be front section/row seating.
- Seating tickets and flowers for the pageant may be pre-purchased in this packet up through the first rehearsal on Wednesday, January 24th.
- **General seating is first come, first serve.** Be sure and arrive as early as **6:15 pm** for the best general seating.
- Turn in all seating and flower orders to **Coach Zingler in Room 206** or **Ciss Welch** at **first rehearsal on Wednesday, January 24th.**

Contestant Arrival:

- Contestants may arrive **as early as 5:30 pm, but NO LATER THAN 6:30 pm on pageant night, Saturday, January 27th.**
- Be sure to check in at the contestant registration desk to get your contestant number. **This number must be worn when on stage at all times!**

Attire Descriptions:

Sportswear:

- In your sportswear (usually interpreted as dressy casual), you will come onstage and introduce yourself.
- This is your first judged appearance of the evening and is a great time to show your personality.

Formal:

- Formal wear is defined as a floor length or short formal dress and will be worn for most of the pageant.
- You will answer your individual interview question in this attire.

Accessories:

- Girls should remember to bring jewelry, hair accessories, pins, mirrors, cosmetics, and any other items that are needed.
- Please be careful to take home all belongings after the pageant.
